

# Frohnleiten Mill

The Frohnleiten mill is the original Mayr-Melnhof Karton mill and was established in 1888. It is MM-Karton's centre of excellence and is where R&D, customer technical support, purchasing and development of maintenance systems are located. The mill produces high quality recycled fibre-based cartonboard grades such as Topcolor, MM Liner and MSC for a variety of specialist and standard packaging applications.

The Frohnleiten mill combines state-of-the-art technology and processes with a highly skilled and knowledgeable workforce. Environmental protection is an important priority at the Frohnleiten mill. As early as 1913, recycled paper was first used as primary material with the commissioning of the first cartonboard machine. Measures to protect the environment are not just limited to production but also include upstream and downstream areas of the supply chain, including purchasing and logistics.
